Dear Parents and Carers,



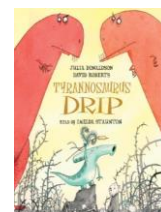

THIS HALF TERM

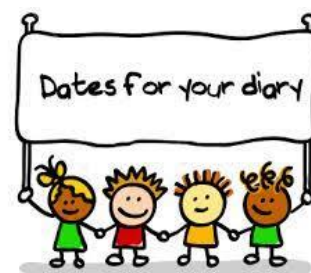


RHYME

Now that the children are fully established into their phase one phonics, we ask for your support in developing their awareness of rhyme and alliteration. You can support this by singing rhymes at home with your child, such as humpty dumpty, incy wincy spider and hickory dickory dock. You can also match rhyming couplet objects such as hat and cat. There are lots of books that develop your child's sense of rhyme such as 'Rumble in the Jungle' by Giles Andreae. Do ask if you'd like more ideas!
