Never Eat Shredded Wheat

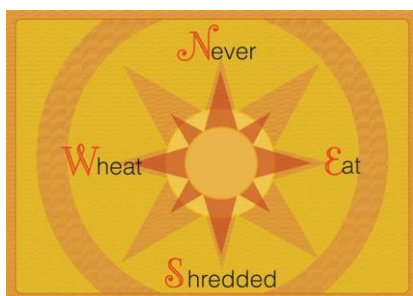
Theme Overview
