



How has Bishop's Stortford changed since the 18th Century?

ART

Study the work of local artist Henry Moore and create a charcoal drawing of one of his sculptures.

MATHS

Add and subtract two 4-digit numbers with re-grouping (exchanging).

Multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000.

SCIENCE

Sound

Identify how we hear sounds, linking this to something vibrating and recognise that these vibrations travel to the ear.

Find patterns between: the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it, and the volume of sound and strength of the vibrations.

Recognise that sounds get fainter as the sound source gets further away.
