Theme Overview

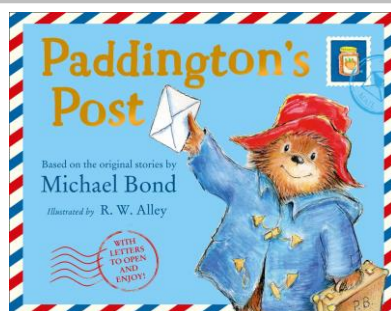
